Dear Dr. Payne

On behalf of the orphaned children in Zambia, Africa we want to thank you for the very generous donation of five computers. Your donation will be used to supply computers to Agape Children's Village School and the Mauriegrace School for orphans in Ndola. As they have nothing at this time, this gift will be a tremendous educational tool for them. I will be going to Africa next week and will be bringing the lap top over for the OMNI representative to use to relay informational needs of the children. The PCs will be shipped on our overseas container to Zambia in March of this year to be distributed by our medical team in June.

We returned from our mission trip to Zambia in July where we treated over 3,000 orphans and the poor in two weeks. As you know, our team is made up of volunteer physicians and nurses from the suburban Detroit area that gives up their time to care for these children. In addition, we built 2 small orphanages that will house 35 orphans and purchased a school in the city to provide education to the street children. We will be building a school for the orphans in the deep bush area next June. We have also provided their village with wells for clean water, livestock, farming equipment, and food.

Our medical and building team was in the deep bush of the Mpongwe region at Agape Children's Farm which is a home to over 10,000 natives. In Zambia one in every 10 people are children who are orphaned secondary to the famine, disease, and exposure.

It is people like you who make the medical mission to Zambia a true success. Please know that your assistance will help to make a difference in the lives of these children and provide hope for their future.
